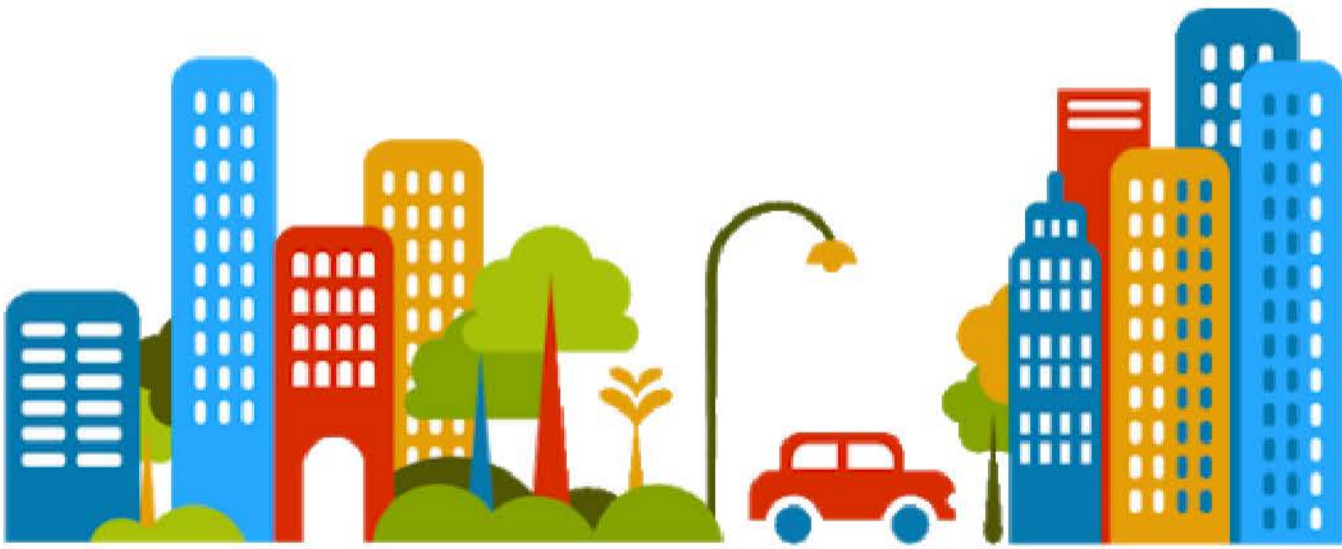

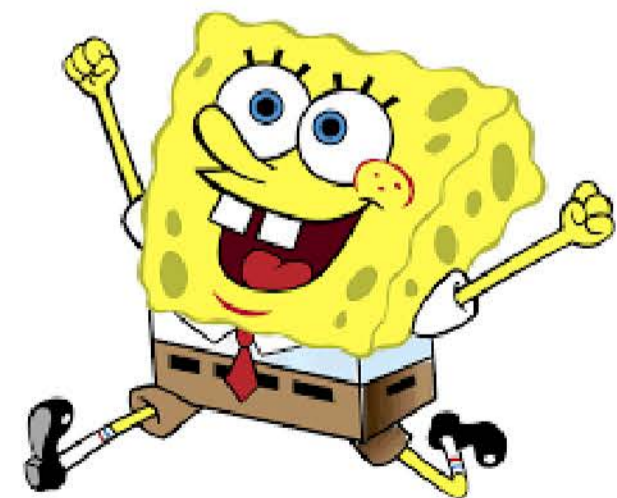

(Furkan, Melih'den daha şışmandır.)
Melih is **healthier** than **Furkan**.
(Melih, Furkan'dan daha sağlıklıdır.)

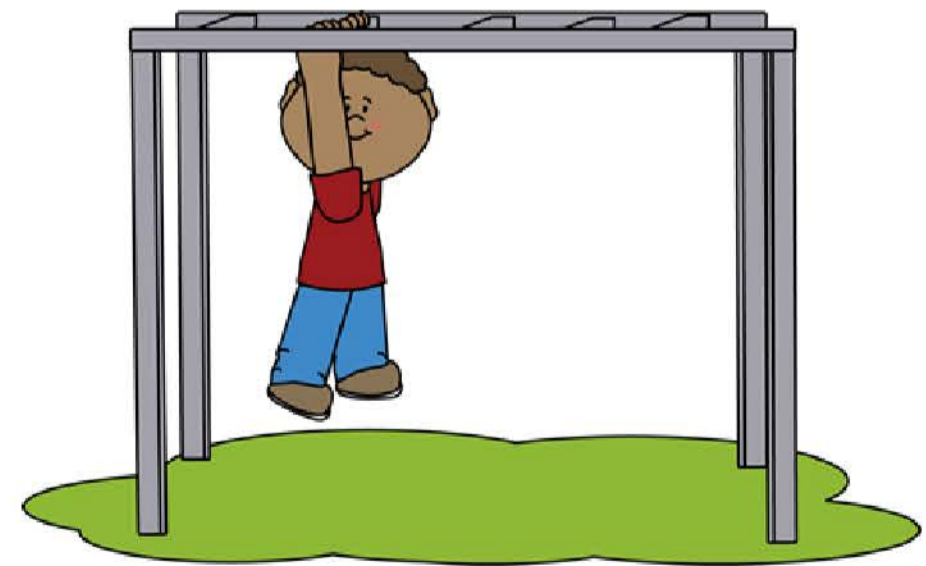
He is flying a kite.

One-syllable adjectives

Adjective

Comparative Degree

small
large

smaller (than)
larger (than)

- Robin is taller (than) Andy.
- I've got nicer hair (than) Alice.

One-syllable adjectives
ending in consonant-vowel-consonant

Comparative Degree

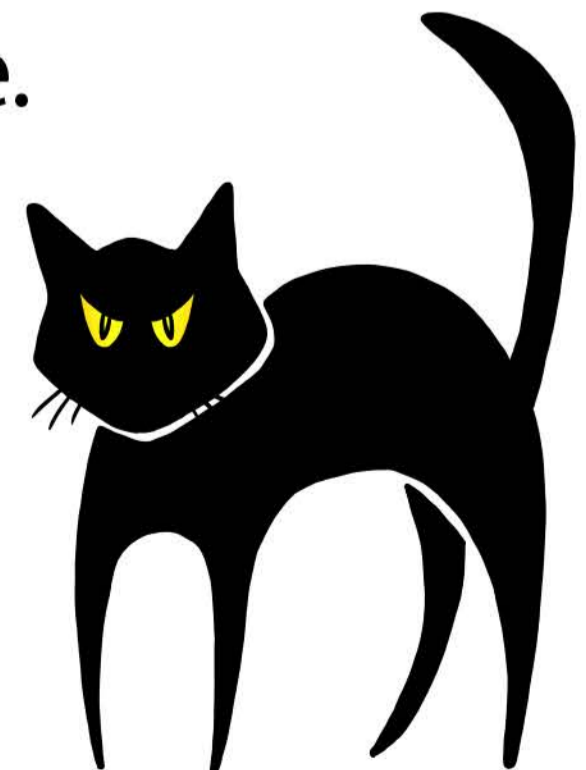
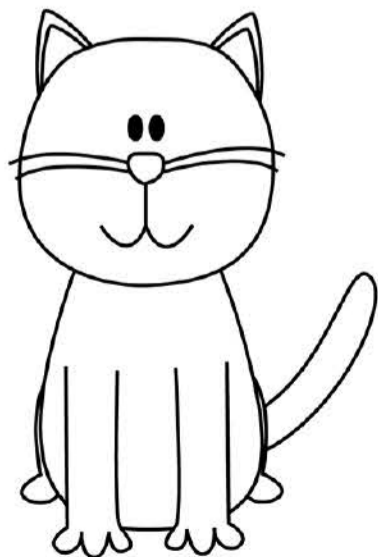
big

bigger (than)

thin

thinner (than)

- The black cat is **thinner than** the white one.

Adjectives
ending in consonant + y

Adjective

Comparative Degree

happy
funny

happier (than)
funnier (than)

- Dad is **funnier than** mum.



Keep in Mind!



Adjectives
with two or more syllables

Adjective

Comparative Degree

boring

more boring (than)

expensive

more expensive (than)

- The blue shoes are **more** comfortable **than** the grey ones.
