The Spanish invaders arrived in Peru in the 1500s. They destroyed almost all the Inca sites, but they missed Machu Picchu because it was located on top of the Andes Mountains. Machu Picchu almost disappeared under the jungle,

but local farmers knew it was there. In 1911, the farmers showed it to an explorer, Hiram Bingham. Bingham excavated the area and explored the buildings, took photos and wrote about this historical site.

The Incas built temples, houses and other buildings with stones. These stones fit each other perfectly. They also had long terraces for farming. About 1,000 people lived there. Today, Machu Picchu is among the most endangered sites in the world. Only up to 2,500 visitors can visit the site per day.
